

Les Misérables – Lent Studies 2023

“The world’s all-time bestseller meets a twenty-first century musical icon. In this course, suitable for group use or personal reflection, Steve Mann skilfully interweaves the Gospel narrative with the story of Les Misérables. Daily devotional readings are built around seven key spiritual themes – grace, responsibility, truth, compassion, fellowship, darkness and reconciliation. These are complemented by weekly study material tied in to the 2012 movie release.”

The book can be bought individually £7.49 on Amazon or I have a few second-hand copies (£3) but the cheapest source is as a kindle download £3.99. (The kindle app is a free download for phone, tablet or computer).

I will supply details of the daily readings weekly for those who do not have the book but this will miss out some of the information – I will not be photocopying all the notes provided in the book.

You do not have to attend every session, though it helps, – you can drop in and out as work and other commitments allow. You can also switch sessions if you wish each week. It is also possible to study this course on your own though it isn’t as much fun.
